Dear Mr. Lulfs:

On behalf of our client, Pilot Travel Centers, LLC (Pilot), we formally request access to the sanitary sewer for discharge from the oil/water separator at the aforementioned facility.

As requested by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Division of Surface Water, Pilot is contacting the sewer districts which service each Pilot Travel Center in the state of Ohio. Your sewer district currently services the facility located at 905 American Road Route 24 in Napoleon.

We have prepared an estimate of expected discharge from the oil/water separator based on a 4-year study of a similar facility in Waynesville, NC. This study indicates the expected discharge from the oil/water separator at the referenced facility will be 0.000148 million gallons per day.

Pilot requests a written response to this letter as soon as possible to begin the planning phase of the connection to the sewer. Please contact this office at (865)588-5422 with any questions.
