33.10-2

Use of Public Sewers Required

- 33.10-2a It shall be unlawful for any person to place, deposit, or permit to be deposited in any unsanitary manner on public or private property within the City of Napoleon, or in any area under the jurisdiction of said City, any human or animal excrement, garbage, or objectionable waste.
- 33.10-2b It shall be unlawful to discharge to any natural outlet within the City of Napoleon, or in any area under the jurisdiction of said City, any wastewater or other polluted waters except where suitable treatment has been provided in accordance with subsequent provisions of this ordinance.
- 33.10-2c Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful to construct or maintain any privy, privy vault, septic tank, cesspool, or other facility intended or used for the disposal of wastewater within the City of Napoleon.
- 33.10-2d The owner(s) of all houses, buildings, or properties used for human occupancy, employment, recreation, or other purposes, situated within the City and abutting on any street, alley, or right-of-way in which there is now located a public sanitary or combined sewer of the City, is hereby required at the owner(s)' expense to install suitable toilet facilities therein, and to connect such facilities directly with the proper public sewer in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, within ninety (90) days after date of official notice to do so, provided that said public sewer is within one hundred (100) feet (30.5 meters) of the property line.
