After discussing this with the City of Napoleon's Law Director and reviewing the City's Rules, Terms, and Conditions Governing the Sale of Electrical Service I must deny your request to install the electric meter in this room. This decision is based upon **Rule 4.4**Meter Installation, which states: The property owner shall furnish a suitable space for the installation of necessary measuring instruments so that the latter may be protected from injury by the elements or through the negligence or deliberate acts of the customer or any employee of the same. The City will furnish, install, and maintain the meter, to be installed outside the building. The meter will be kept in a place readily accessible for purposes of reading by utility personnel, not to be fenced.
