Dear Mr. Rohrs:

It has come to my attention that your house at 323 E. Clinton has a sewer line break in the basement. This break shall be corrected before rental of the house. The basement floor has raw sewage laying on it and is a matter of health to any occupants.

Upon inspection of the basement, it was noted that there were numerous electrical violations within the basement and that the electric service to the house is only 60 amps. The National Electric Code requires 100 amp services for residential dwellings. Correction of the electrical within the dwelling and the installation of a 100 amp service shall be required before the house is rerented.
