The city will reimburse the owner for sidewalk replacement in the right-of-way at a rate of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per square foot, if installed in accordance to City specifications. The City will reimburse the owner for curbing replacement in the right-of-way at a rate of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per linear foot, if installed in accordance to City specification. Reimbursement is made to the owner of the property not the contractor. IT is required that the owner completes an invoice (provided by the City) for such work along with a paid copy of the invoice from the contractor who performed such work (if applicable). Name of City registered contractor performing such work; (if there is no contractor involved mark Self) City Lic. # Signature of property owner This form must be signed by the City Engineer prior to commencement of work in order to be eligible for

reimbursement according to the above schedule. Inspection by the City is required prior to placement of concrete and after work is completed. A "WORK IN RIGHT OF WAY" PERMIT IS REQUIRED BEFORE WORK MAY COMMENCE.

This project as specified above is hereby approved for construction and is <u>eligible</u> for reimbursement in accordance with the schedule herein. All work must conform to the City of Napoleon specification.



## City of Napoleon

### Residential Sidewalk Specifications

#### I. Work Included

- A. Under this item the Contractor shall improve by construction, reconstruction or repairing as is necessary, public sidewalks between limits established by the Engineer.
- B. Sidewalks shall be at least four (4) inches in thickness and, in driveway crossings and within five (5) feet there of, six (6) inches in thickness. When sidewalks abut with the curb, the width shall be five (5) feet or as wide as the existing sidewalks; in either case, a minimum width of four (4) feet shall be required. Edge of walks parallel with the street shall be placed at least one (1) foot from the property line or meet existing sidewalks. The Engineering Department will give line and grade.
- C. Old concrete sidewalk material shall be removed and granular material used for fill if necessary, to meet grade.
- D. All work shall conform to the standard specifications published by the Ohio Department of Transportation (O.D.O.T.) and the City, in effect at the date of contract and the requirements under these specifications.

511.15 Depositing and Curing Concrete in Cold Weather

#### II. Materials and Finish:

- A. A minimum of four (4) inches of ODOT item 304 or 411 crushed limestone base shall be provided and compacted in place.
- B. The concrete mix shall be ODOT Class C mix with 5 to 6% air entrainment. All surface area shall be broom finished and sealed with an Engineer approved concrete sealer. All joints shall be trowel-cut with a maximum joint spacing of 5 feet. The depth of cut shall be a minimum ¼ of the thickness of the slab. Expansion joints shall be placed at a maximum of 40 feet and at all intersecting walks. Admixtures shall only be added after approval of the City Engineer. Calcium Chloride shall **NOT** be added to the mix.
- C. Contact the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department for additional information when constructing concrete walks if the atmospheric temperature may drop below 40 degrees Fahrenheit in the first seven (7) days after construction.
