with the terms of this code.
Permanent storage for the purpose
of this subsection shall be construed
as the presence of such storage for a
period of 72 or more consecutive
hours in any one week period.
We hereby request that you comply
with the above point of Section 85.24.

It has been brought to our attention and after due inspection, we find that you are violating City Ordinance No. 1104, Section 85.24, under the heading of storage as follows:

"No portion of any required yard shall be used for the permanent storage of motor vehicles, trailers, airplanes, boats, or parts thereof, rubbish, garbage, junk, tent or building materials except during construction and in accordance with the terms of this code."

"Permanent storage for the purpose of this subsection shall be construed as the presence of such storage for a period of 48 or more consecutive hours in any one week period."

We hereby request that you comply with the above part of Section 85.24.
