Dear Mr. Koesters:

In response to our meeting of June 30, 1999, I have spoken with representatives of the Ohio EPA. Based upon the information you provided pertaining to the number of lots and average number of residents per lot, I have determined that a total of nine (9) chimney seals would need to be installed within your development for removal of inflow and infiltration (I/I) to allow the proposed sanitary sewer extension. This number was developed as follows:

(11 New Lots) x (3.0 Persons per Lot) x (100 GPD per Capita) = 3,300 GPD Additional Flow

(3,300 GPD Additional) x (2.0 GPD of I/I per GPD Additional) = 6,600 GPD of I/I

(6,600 GPD of I/I) / (600 GPD of I/I per Seal) = 8.25 Seals (Use 9 Chimney Seals)

As we discussed, there are other possible options to accomplish the required removal of I/I from the sanitary collection system. These options range from replacing perforated castings with solid, gasketed castings to complete manhole removal and replacement to sewer rehabilitation. The Ohio EPA does not currently have a summary of rehabilitation items versus removal credits, but will review each proposed project for removal credits. An estimate of the amount of removal for each project by an engineer may be submitted for their consideration.

On behalf of the City of Napoleon, we will approve the plans as currently proposed upon receipt of a letter confirming the commitment of your firm, including a specific date for the completion, to perform a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project, such as chimney seal installation.

Plans & Specifications:

- 1. Cover Sht. The detailed specifications provided do not specifically require no greater than 5.0% deflection for the sanitary sewers. This test will be performed, per City of Napoleon standards, prior to approval of the sanitary sewer construction.
- 2. Sht. 4 of 4 The sanitary manhole still does not show an integral base section. A precast section shall be provided. Also, please provide my office with a catalog cut for the Neenah R-1045 casting called out on the plans. My Neenah catalog does not have that item. Otherwise an East Jordan 1045, casting with a gasketed, solid lid, or an approved equal, shall be provided.

Also, a meeting will need to be scheduled with the Ohio EPA to discuss the required upgrades to the existing sanitary collection system. These plans may be submitted to the Ohio EPA for their review.

- Per the City of Napoleon Engineering Rules and Regulations, a plan review fee of \$25.00 and an inspection of 1.50% of the estimated cost of the improvements are required.
- Please make sure that your contractor is registered with the City of Napoleon. Registration forms are available at the City offices.
- You may commence with the installation of the proposed 2" water main and concrete pads, as previously approved by the State Department of Health.
- No construction will be permitted for the proposed 8" sanitary sewer extension until a Permit to Install is issued by the Ohio EPA. I would assume that such a permit would not be issued any sooner than 60 to 90 days from submittal due to the issues (SSO's and the pumping station) we discussed previously. Also, obviously, none of the proposed lots may be occupied until the sanitary sewer and service connections are installed.

I have reviewed the issue of the sanitary sewers within the Glenwood Estates with the Ohio EPA and have been informed that the Ohio EPA must issue a Permit to Install (PTI) for all sewers, pumping stations and wastewater treatment facilities even if they are to be located within a mobile home park. Also, PTI's expire if construction on the proposed improvements does not commence within eighteen (18) months after issuance. Finally, the City of Napoleon Engineering Rules & Regulations have a one (1) year expiration period.

Therefore, the Ohio EPA and the City of Napoleon will need to review the plans for the proposed sewer extension prior to commencing with the construction. You should be aware that the City has two (2) sanitary sewer overflows (SSO's) downstream of this facility which will need to be addressed. We also have some concerns regarding the amount of inflow and infiltration entering the existing sanitary sewer system within the Glenwood Estates and will be reviewing that issue along with the above plan review.
