I have received complaints regarding the operation of a dog kennel in a residential district. It is illegal to operate a kennel in any residential district in accordance to Napoleon City Code Title 151. A kennel is defined as ANY PREMISES ON WHICH FOUR OR MORE DOGS, OR SMALL ANIMALS, AT LEAST FOUR MONTHS OF AGE ARE KEPT. Also you have placed the kennel over a City alley which again is illegal for you to do and may subject you to criminal trespass.

You are hereby ordered to cease and desist all kennel operations and remove the kennel from City owned property.

If I do not receive a response from you regarding the above issue within 5 days of receipt of this letter, I shall file a complaint with the City Prosecutor and if necessary institute a suit for injunction in the Common Pleas Court of Henry County Ohio.
