An inspection of the septic tank located near the Lawrence Hause, President southeast corner of the property of 410 Fair St., has revealed that attention must be given to this situation.

> The Van Hyning sanitary sewer has been completed for some time now, and all landowners are required to connect their sewer taps into this system.

The septic tank on this property has been found to still be in operation. You are hereby notified that this tank shall be disconnected and plugged at both the inlet and the outlet. The tank shall then be filled with sand or crushed stone, or it may be removed entirely. The house connection shall then be made with the new tap, which is located at the stake which is also in the southeast corner of said property.

This work shall be completed within 30 days (September 14, 1981) and before disconnection, the City's Inspector shall be notified to oversee the disconnection and connection process.
