Gentlemen:

In reply to your letter of January 25, 1962, the 6" water main in Filmore Street is 42 feet from the south face of the Napco Plastics Building.

The tapping machine we use is adaptable to any 6" mechanical joint tapping valve and sleeve. The gland for the mechanical joint sleeve should be over-sized to fit sand-cast cast iron pipe.

Our part in making the tap will be to install the tapping sleeve and then making the tap. We will not do any excavating for the hole but we will keep the hole dry and do any hand digging that may be required to set the tapping machine in position. Our cost for making the tap is \$250.00.
