ORDINANCE NO. 48-00

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING COUNTY ROAD "R" WITHIN THE CORPORATION LIMITS TO THAT OF: FREEDOM DRIVE

Whereas, a portion of County Road "R" also known as Township Road "R", hereinafter referred to as Road "R" between Oakwood Avenue was annexed into the City limits several years ago; and,

Whereas, at time of annexation Road "R" was not given a City street name; and,

Whereas, George Nicely of N&R&G Recycling is an owner of a lot(s) in the vicinity of the proposed street and there has been a petition generated by the owner to change the name of Road "R" within the corporate limits pursuant to ORC 723.04; and,

Whereas, after hearing that was held on February 7, 2000, the Council finds that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that it should be made; moreover, finding that this action may also constitute an original naming of the street;

Whereas, debate was had at numerous meetings of Council whether to name the street "Commerce Drive" or "Freedom Drive"; and,

Whereas, Council decided on "Freedom Drive"; Now Therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

- **Section 1.** That, the portion of Road "R" between Oakwood Avenue and easterly termini within the corporation limits of the municipality shall be renamed "Freedom Drive".
- Section 2. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Codified Ordinances of Napoleon Ohio.
- Section 3. That, if any other prior Ordinance or Resolution is found to be in conflict with this Ordinance, then the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail. Further, if any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof.
- **Section 4.** That, upon passage, this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
