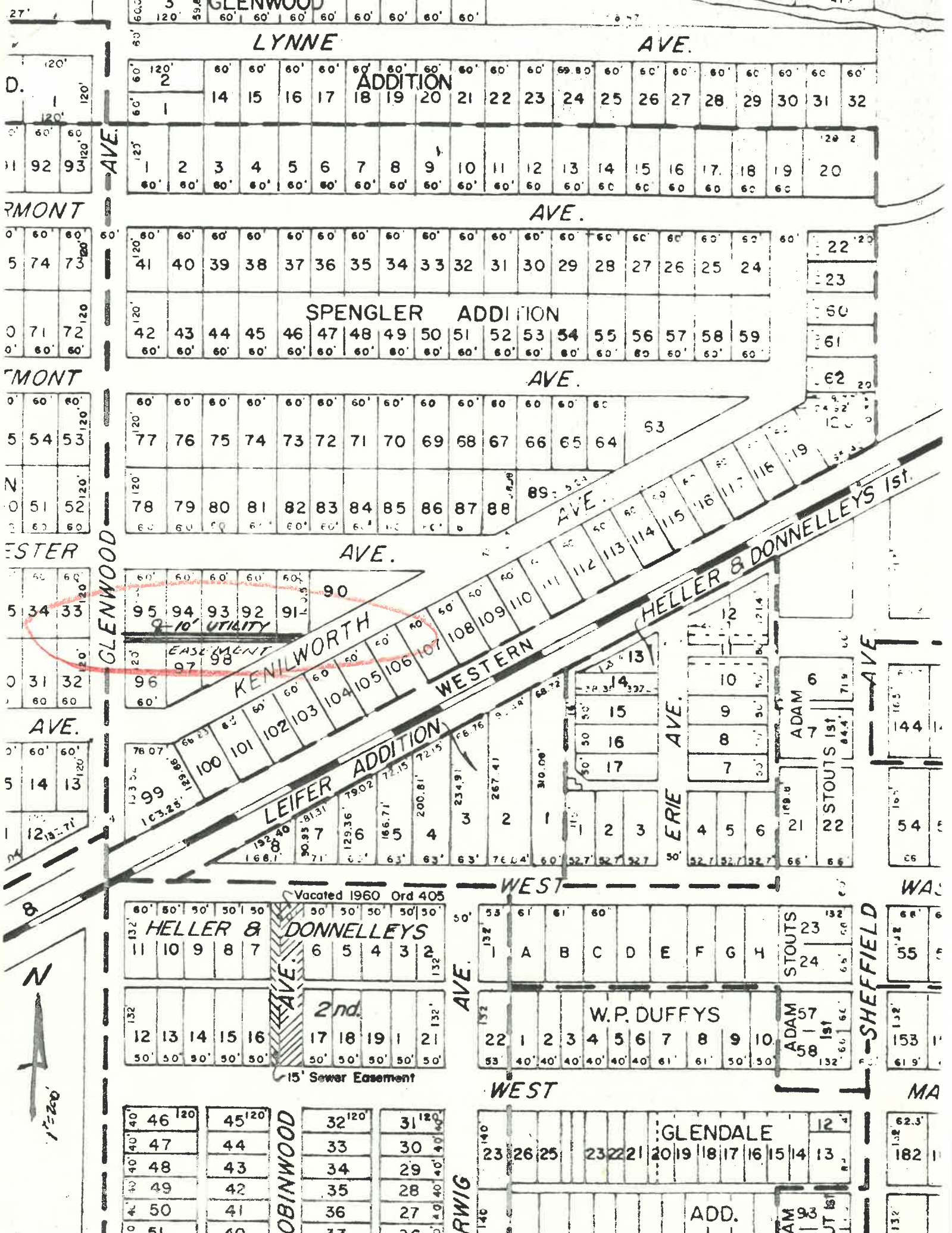
We do know there is an Ohio Gas service line in the easement, which will be removed.
