The site for the proposed AMP-Ohio Napoleon Distributive Generation Station along the west edge of 1775 Industrial Drive (City of Napoleon Service Garage) is in an I-2 Open Industrial Zoning District. In accordance with City Code Chapter 531 "Noise Control" the maximum noise level permitted in this district is 80 dBA at any time of day. According to City Code Chapter 1141 publicly operated facilities are permitted in the I-2 Open Industrial District through the issuance of a Special Use Permit by City Council. We have a public hearing scheduled for April 13, 1999 with the City Planning Commission who will then make recommendation to City Council on April 19, 1999 for final action and approval. Because this is a permitted use through the issuance of a Special Use Permit the only issues that may affect the installation would be cost related (i.e. screening, noise level abatement, etc.) There would be no issues which could prohibit the installation.

I will be in contact with you as to the outcome of the Planning Commission public hearing and subsequent City Council meeting. I will then issue a Zoning Permit accordingly when appropriate.
