As we have discussed, the zoning permit for the newly constructed warehousing facility at 1800 Industrial Drive was issued with the understanding that a permanent easement would be granted to the City for the existing water main serving your facility at 1800 Industrial Drive. A copy of my facsimile of January 27, 1999 is enclosed for your reference. One (1) copy of a permanent easement for the water main was provided under a cover letter dated May 3, 1999. As of the date of this correspondence, the permanent easement has yet to be received by the City.

Finance Director Gregory J. Heath If the required permanent easement is not executed and returned to the City within thirty (30) days of the date of this correspondence, it would be the City's intent to install a master meter at the easterly right-of-way line of Industrial Drive. There would be a charge to your company for the cost of installation. Further, the City would not provide service nor maintain the existing water main beyond the meter assembly.

The following is a list of comments developed for the referenced project:

General:

1. A plan review fee of \$25.00 is required. An inspection fee of 1.5% of the estimated cost of construction, plus contingencies will also be required. Based upon the estimate provided the inspection fee will be \$1,469.26 (\$85,174.50 x 1.15 x 1.50%). Both fees are due prior to commencing with construction.

Sheets 1 & 2:

- ৰ্ব. In order to avoid any confusion over the ownership of the proposed water main and the resulting backflow requirements, a fifteen (15) foot wide permanent easement centered on the water main must be granted. The City will then accept the main as a public water main. Otherwise, a meter pit with the proper backflow device will be required to be installed as well.
- As a suggestion, the owner may wish to install a tee and valve on the new main for the future building. It is their option.
