

Dear Mr. Tipping:

I was requested to do an inspection of the electrical facilities in a rental dwelling owned by you at 312 E. Main St.

I did the inspection on Thursday, December 16, 1982 and found that the following items are a hazard to the health and welfare of the tenants.

60 amp service shall be raised to 100 amp minimum as per 230-79 C of the National Electric Code.

All wiring within the dwelling shall be upgraded to meet the National Electric Code.

Disconnect and circuit breakers shall be removed and installed with new. All receptacles and lighting circuits shall be 20 and 15 amp.

Along with this inspection, I noticed a considerable amount of garbage, rubbish and debris within the house. We also have been receiving complaints about the rubbish being put out days before the pickup day and then the dogs get into it and scatter it around.

Your cooperation in the above mentioned conditions is appreciated.

The electrical shall be corrected within fifteen (15) days receipt of this letter.
