At 1:00 p.m. the same day we did an inspection of the residence with the Street Supervisor, who does the exterminating for the City of Napoleon. The presence of rats within the dwelling was viewed and determined to be a hazard to the occupants of the building.

I am issuing a judication order under the Nuisance Ordinance 1705, Section 92.02 that the above referenced property shall be exterminated by an extermination company within 10 days of this notice and shall continue to be exterminated until the presence of rodents is removed. The exterminating company shall issue a letter to this Department every time the extermination is completed.
