On the fence dividing Central Junior High's football field and playground, there has been a length of UF cable fastened to the top of the fence and run from a white wood frame building south to a point in back of a temporary concession stand. The line is considered a temporary line and shall be removed.

Law Director

The line shall either be run underground or in the air to a pole with a weather proof receptacle. It shall also have a ground fault circuit interupter connected. The receptacle shall be installed as close to the concession stand or attached to the stand. No cord shall extend from the stand to the fence and if the line is overhead, it shall be 10 ft. above the ground. No cords shall be placed so that any person can reach them or run into them.

The protection of the people attending the games or using either area as a practice or play area shall be taken into consideration. The existing situation does not allow this protection.
