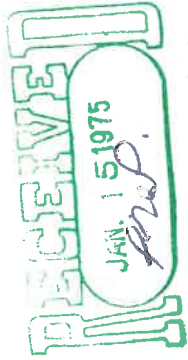

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that whereas, the board of education of the Napoleon City School District, a school district of the State of Ohio, by resolution duly adopted by a majority of its members, at a regular meeting duly held on the 20th day of October, 1974, elected to sell and dispose of the personal property hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, said board of education, having first given at least thirty days' notice of the time and place of sale thereof by advertising for sale at public auction; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of December, 1974, said board of education, in pursuance of said advertisement, did expose said personal property for sale at public auction, and the same was then and there publicly sold and struck off to Warren Detmer, of Holgate, Ohio for the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00), he being the highest bidder therefor.

The two-story residence located at 217 W. Main Street, City of Napoleon, Henry County, Ohio, consisting of seven rooms and a bath with furnace and waterheater.

To have and to hold the same unto said Warren Detmer, his heirs and assigns forever, provided, however, that said building is removed from the lot owned by grantor on or before the first day of June, 1975, in accordance with the written advertisements and statements made on the day of sale.
