The Ohio Sales Tax Law provides that no vendor shall fail to collect the full and exact tax as required by Sections

The Ohio Sales Tax Law provides that no vendor shall fail to collect the full and exact tax as required by Sections 5739.01 to 5739.31, inclusive, of the Revised Code, or fail to comply with such sections and the rules and regulations of the tax commissioner with respect to the cancellation of prepaid tax receipts.

Whoever violates this provision shall be fined not less than twenty-five nor more than one hundred dollars for a first offense; for each subsequent offense such person shall, if a corporation, be fined not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars, or if an individual or a member of a partnership, firm, or association, be fined not less than twenty-five nor more than one hundred dollars, or imprisoned not more than sixty days, or both.

- ON 1/7/75 Rupert Schweinhagen informed me that about a year ago Mrs. Desgrange was informed it was a prohibited use of the bldg. to repair motorbikes. Nothing on record regarding this matter.

- Rupert also informed me that before the zoning ordinance 1104 went into effect, 906 W. Main St. was a Repair Shop for Lawnmowers, which is non-conforming but permissible under Sec. 85.09.

(Phone Call) ON 1/20/75 Mrs. Desgrange owner of 906 W. Main St and Mrs. Wilhelm admitted to the fact automotive work was taken place in the bldg.

- Both Mrs. Desgrange & Mrs. Wilhelm was informed this type of usage of the bldg. was prohibited.

Dear Mrs. Desgrange:

O The subject residence was inspected by me on January 16,
1975 and the following facts were evident:

- P
1. Inside of the structure was two automobiles with the hoods up, indicating repair work of the engines was in progress.
 2. It appears to me the building is being used for automotive repair work.
 3. This is not a permitted use in an "A" Residence District.

Y As per discussed during our conversation on the telephone on January 20, 1975, you, as the owner of 906 W. Main St., are in direct violation with Section 85.13 and could be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 85.99 of the City of Napoleon Zoning Ordinance No. 1104.

Therefore, you must discontinue any type of repair work on automobiles within fourteen (14) days from the date of this notice and make sure this type of usage of the building does not occur again or the City of Napoleon will have no other alternative but to take legal action against you.

So that there is no misunderstanding, again I am informing you 906 W. Main St. may be used for a repair work shop for lawn mowers and smaller items. Repair work of any nature on automobiles or motorbikes is not permitted.
