Notice To Connect To Sanitary Sewer
(City Code Section 52.11 & 52.12)

Pursuant to Section 52.11 of the City Code, you are hereby given official notice that within ninety (90) days of receipt of this notice, you must connect into the public sanitary sewer system at your own expense. Moreover, pursuant to City Code Section 52.12, if you are currently being served with a private wastewater disposal system, you must make direct connection to the public sewer system within sixty (60) days and any septic tanks, cesspools, and similar private wastewater disposal facilities shall be cleaned of sludge and filled with suitable material.

Failure to comply with the above is a violation of the City Code and is punishable as follows:

Guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined no less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 and may be further fined \$50.00 for each day the violation continues.

Please contact the City Department of Engineering (419) 592-4010 for information as to proper permits and other required information.

Note: Connection required if sanitary sewer is within one hundred feet (100') of the property line.
