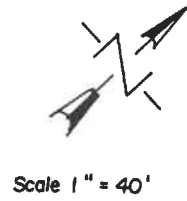


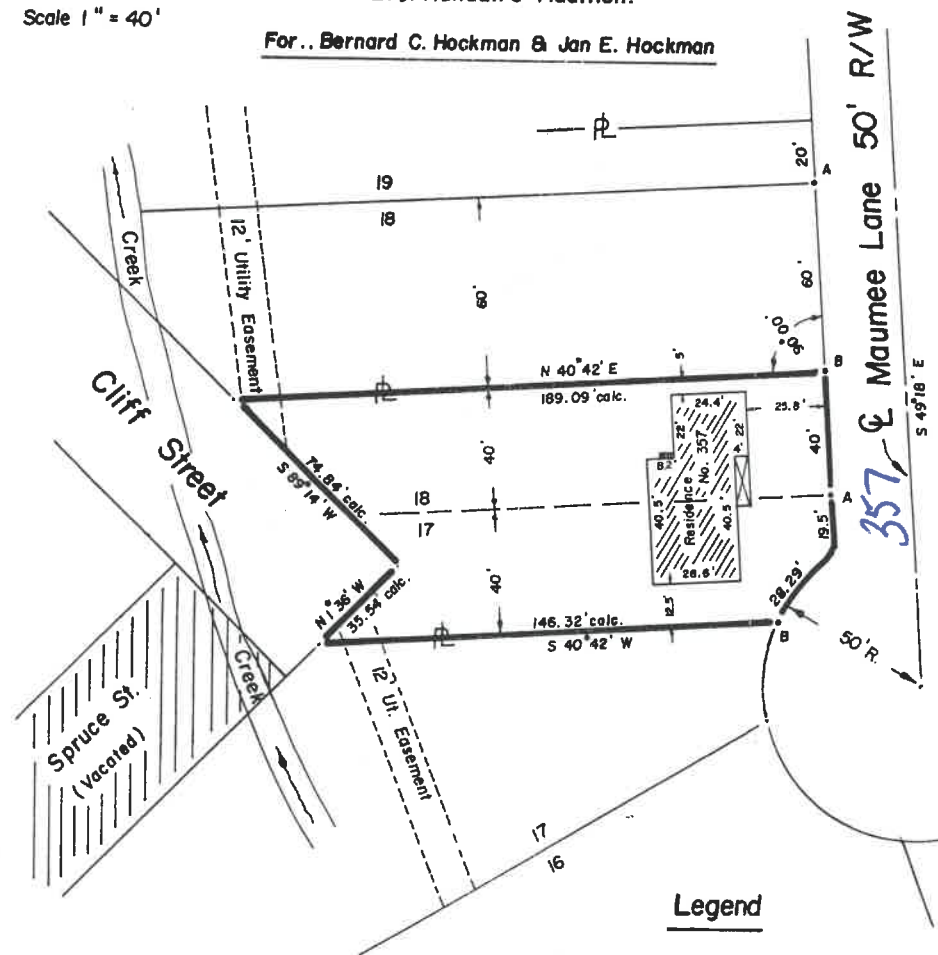

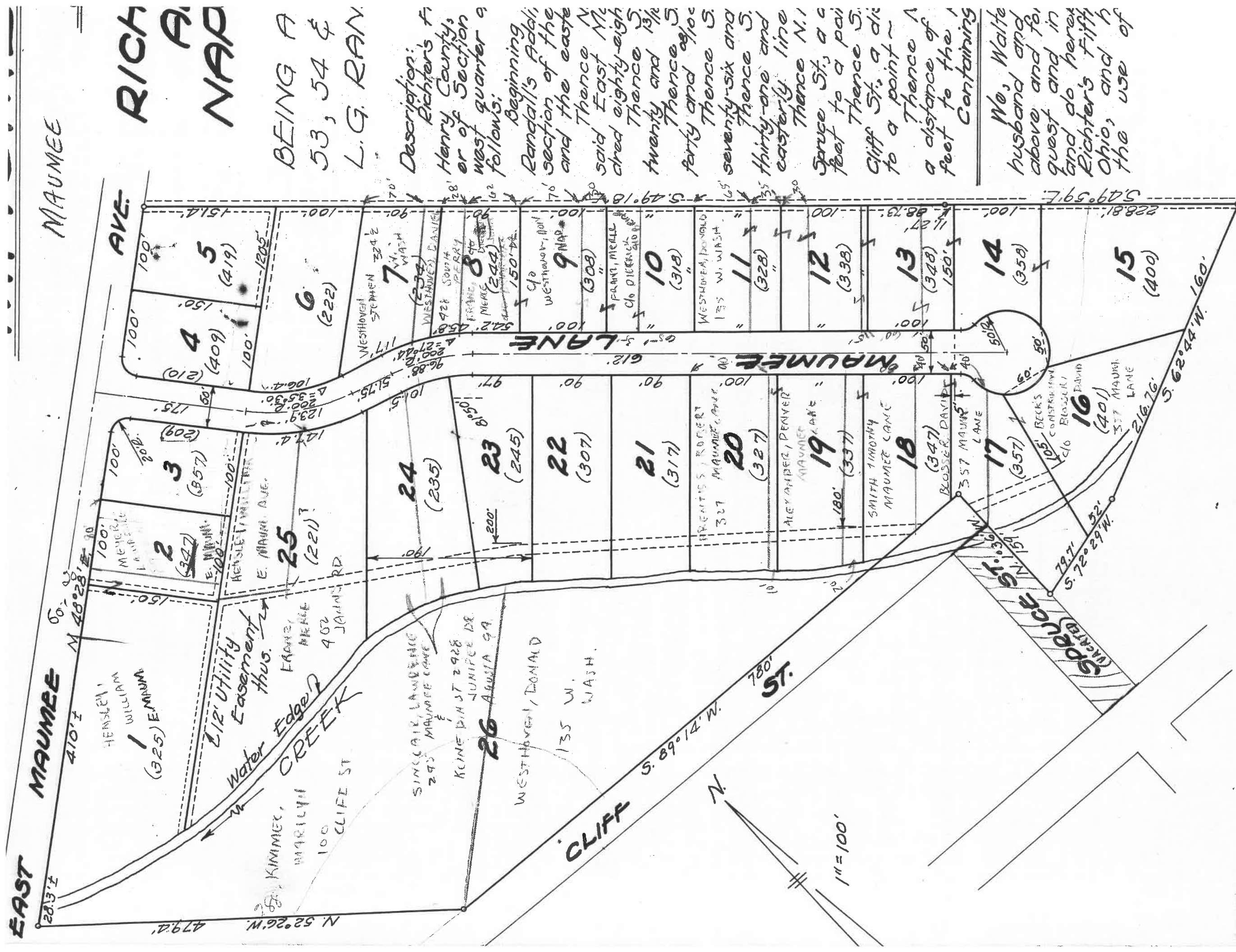


Legend
