BACKGROUND:

An application by The Bischoff Company 19 Lakeview Napoleon Ohio, owner of a parcel of land know as lot 18 of E.T. Barnes addition to Napoleon, further known as 303 Meekison Napoleon, Ohio, requesting final plat approval of a Minor Subdivision thereof. The request is pursuant to the City of Napoleon Ohio Code of General Ordinances Chapter 154 entitled "Subdivision Control Code", and is located in a "A" Residential Zoning District.

RESEARCH AND FINDINGS:

- The proposed lot split does not conform to the minimum lot square footage requirements of the applicable district.
- 2. The applicant has requested variance to the minimum lot square footage from the Board of Zoning Appeals and the Board approved the request 12/13/94.
- 3. There are several lot splits of this type in immediate area.
- 4. When Mr. Bischoff purchased the subject property he was under the impression that the lot had been previously split as he had a copy of a 1952 survey which shows such a slit, but it was not recorded at the H.C. Recorders office, so it was never made official.

ADMINISTRATIVE OPINION AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

I am recommending this proposed lot split request as it is reasonable

The Planning Commission recommends that City Council approve the Minor Subdivision as requested.
