ADDENDUM TO PLAN APPROVAL
HAUFFMAN HOUSE

This addendum is attached to and is a part of the plans. All items listed below will be performed and will be incorporated into the structure.

1. Type A or B hardware shall be installed on the front door street level and the back basement door alley level as required under Section BB-16-13 of the Ohio Building Code.
2. Type A or B exit signs shall be installed at the door top of stairs leading to basement and at the back basement door as required under Section BB-63-18 of the Ohio Building Code.
3. The stairway shall be enclosed using material affording a 2 hour fire-resistance rating and the door shall be Class A or B self-closing. The enclosure shall extend from the first floor to the ceiling as required under Section BB-63-16 of the Ohio Building Code.
4. The stairway shall be Class A or B as required under Section BB-23-39 of the Ohio Building Code.
5. The toilet rooms shall conform to Section BB-21-12 of the Ohio Building Code.
6. The furnace shall be enclosed in a room constructed in accordance with Section BB-7-45 of the Ohio Building Code.
7. Combustion air for the furnace shall be provided and conform to Section BB-47-30 of the Ohio Building Code.
8. Due to the entire building interior having openings from one area to another the interior finish shall be Class A as required under Section BB-63-30 of the Ohio Building Code.

9. The ventilation of the building and cooking spaces shall conform to Section BB-47-18 of the Ohio Building Code. The hood shall be certified.
10. Fire extinguishing equipment must comply with Section BB-63-32 of the Ohio Building Code.

Dear Mr. Richardson:

In reference to the installation of carpet on the South side wall on the first floor -

Please refer to Mr. Jones's (C.E.O. and Plan Examiner) addendum to the Certificate Of Structural Plan Approval you received on February 23, 1976. If you will note Item No. 8 which states, "Due to the entire building interior having openings from one area to another the interior finish shall be Class "A" as required under Section BB-63-30 of the Ohio Building Code." This is a classification of materials tested under the Tunnel Test (ASTM E 84 Standards) in order to determine flame spread, smoke density, and combustibility. Class "A" designation requires materials to be flameproof and noncombustible with a numerical scale end-point rating of OTO 25.

The letter Mr. Johnson of Johnson's Wholesale Carpet gave me on March 19, 1976 was to certify that the carpet installed on the floor was tested in accordance with the standard designation DOC FF 1-70 (Pile Test), This standard applies only to floor wearing surface installation.

Therefore, if you or Mr. Johnson can certify by submitting the test results of an accredited authoritative agency that tested a sample of the specific carpet (or any other carpet you want to install on a wall) in accordance with the standard A.S.T.M. E 84-70 and it meets Class "A" requirements, then the carpet may remain on the wall. If you are unable to

obtain the approved required test results, then the carpet shall be removed from the South side wall before the required "Certificate Of Occupancy" will be issued. These conditions and requirements shall prevail even after the issuance of the C.O. or Haufman House Restaurant at the address mentioned above could be subject to an adjudication order.
