Judy Bauman has asked if a 6 ft. chain-link fence could be placed in the right-of-way along Hobson running south from W. Clinton 165 ft. The right-of-way of Hobson is 82.5 ft. There is 29 ft. of gr ss from the property line to the edge of the street. They want to place the fence 10 ft. off the property line into the right-of-way.

I am not in favor of anyone placing a fence in street right-of-way. Last year Alan Tandy allowed a property across W. Clinton and to the east to erect a split-rail fence one ft. off the curb. I was not in favor of this and expressed my concern. Allowing this fence in the right-of-way could open a can of worms, if other persons would want a fence. I do not care what way the decision goes but would like to know if Council should rule on this or if I can allow it.
