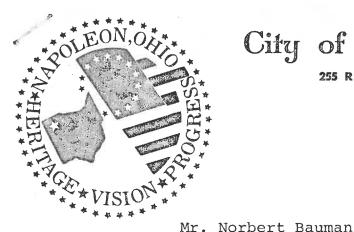

We have reviewed your preliminary and final plats and would request the following changes be made before submission to the Planning Commission.

- A. Add or change the following on the preliminary plat:
 - 1. Add any proposed restrictions on the lots or protective covenants.
 - Setback along Northoaks Drive on Lots #6,
 7, 8, 9 & 10 should be a minimum of 35' to conform to the Zoning Ordinance.
 - 3. Setback line on Lot #10 along Oakwood is already established @ 30' and should remain 30'.
 - 4. Setback on Lot #5 along Oakwood recommend 30' to remain consistent with that to north and south.
 - 5. Petition for zoning change to "S"
 Suburban Residence District for
 Lot #6 thru 10, in conjunction with
 application for preliminary plat
 approval.
 - 6. Ordinance No. 1271 requires 8" water line in residential area. Proposed 6" should be increased to 8".

When the items above are completed, please submit three copies of revised preliminary plat with applications (enclosed) and \$25.00 filing fee for Planning Commission Hearing.

- B. Add or change the following on the final plat:
 - 1. Accurate survey and metes and bounds description of the boundary of the tract.
 - 2. Source of Title to the land, as shown in the records of the Henry County Recorder.
 - 3. Show easements to be provided (especially easement for storm sewer).
 - 4. Building setback lines as follows:
 - a. 30' on east side of Lot #10 as established in previous plat.
 - b. 35' on Lots #6 thru #10 along Northoaks Drive.
 - c. Setback on Lot #5 along Oakwood; minimum required is 25', however, we would suggest a dimension of 30' to remain consistent with those lines to the north and south.
 - 5. Survey monumentation as approved by the City Engineer. PURSUANT to SEC. 84.5 (a).
 - 6. Any restrictions or covenants.
 - 7. Name and address of the owners and subdividers.

If final plat approval is being sought at this time, the following items should also be submitted:

- 1. A surety bond for proposed improvement in accordance with Section 84.3(h)(1)(B).
- 2. A petition, survey and property description for Lots #6 thru #10 requesting a change in zoning to the "S" Suburban Residence District.

I would also question the use of Northoaks Drive as a street name. The City of Napoleon currently has streets named North Street, Northcrest Drive, Northcrest Circle, Oak Street, Oakwood, Oakdale and another Oak Drive located just outside the City limits. I feel this name might not only be confusing but dangerous in emergency situations where a misunderstanding could easily occur.
