Gentlemen:

In response to your request dated 5-12-71 relating to Northcrest Apartments Addition Building Permit, we have the following:

The Building Construction Permit is Permit No. 17. It was issued on April 19, 1971 to Arthur Germann, builder, for owner Charles Bauman, by City Engineer Carl Ingle. The permit is for multiple dwelling construction in Northcrest Addition, lot number 42.

The lot is in an Open Industrial zoned area of the city.

Open Industrial Zoning in the City Zoning Ordinance does not include multiple dwellings in the construction descriptions relating to Open Industrial Zoning.

However, certain restrictions were accepted at the time Northcrest Addition was accepted by the city. The date of acceptance was May 12, 1966. The specific restriction prevailing in this instance, as pointed out by the City Engineer, states the following:

"Lots number 42 through 53 inclusive shall be used for single and multiple family residential and limited and general business purposes, all in accord with the provisions of the aforementioned Zoning Ordinance and to restrictions set out herein."
