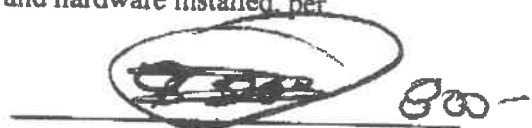

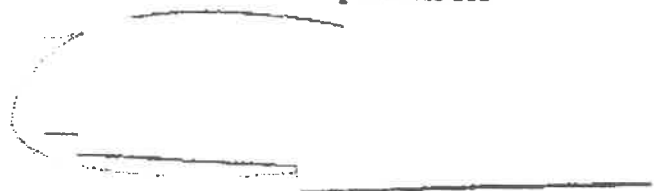

6. Window Replacement: Replace the TWO (2) North-East bay windows with new white vinyl, double glazed, double pane bay windows, complete with finished, wooden, insulated sill and header. Approximate sizes of the TWO (2) windows are... 9' X 5'. Contractor is responsible for own measurements in computing bid.

INTERIOR

1. Electrical: Inspect the existing breaker panel for proper ground and bonding and perform proper bonding and grounding as necessary.

-Basement: Replace the 20 Amp fuse at the furnace with a 15 Amp fuse.

Supply electrical feed and single receptacle to the water heater for proposed "power vent" system.

1st Floor Bath/Utility: Replace the duplex receptacle at the washer area with a single receptacle.

Replace the wall light fixture with a wall switched light bar.

Inspect and correct the wiring to the GFCI receptacle.

-Bedroom #1: Remove the floor receptacle at the North location and install a metal blank cover.

Install an additional wall receptacle to replace the floor receptacle.

Replace the existing wall light fixture, between the bedroom and bathroom, with an enclosed light fixture.

-Bedroom #2: Properly balance the existing ceiling fan.

Exterior Lighting: Replace the existing exterior light fixture at the North entry with a new exterior light fixture, cost not to exceed \$30.00, less installation.

Smoke Detectors: Install THREE (3) U.L. approved, hardwired, smoke detectors, with battery back-up, wired in series for simultaneous alert. Locate ONE (1) in each the basement, Master Bed hallway, and second floor landing locations.

NOTE: All electrical work must conform to NEC and local regulations and be performed by qualified electrical technicians.

Electrical contractor is responsible for repairing all areas damaged by electrical work. All repairs must match existing surfaces as closely as possible.

2. Plumbing: Secure additional water supply line straps and/or anchors at 3' intervals, in the basement location.

Basement floor drain: Clean out (snake) the basement floor drain, to eliminate storm water back-up.

Water heater: Replace the water heater with a minimum 5 year warranty, gas fired, 40 gallon water heater. Water lines must be connected to the water heater with di-electric unions. Remove the existing flue and cap off at basement location. Properly vent the new water heater through the foundation wall, with "power vent" system.

Gas supply pipe: Cap off the stub end of the line, at the West location, using a black iron cap.

Master bath: Replace the toilet tank components with a toilet tank replacement kit.

NOTE: All plumbing work must conform to The Ohio Plumbing Code and local regulations and be performed by a qualified plumbing contractor.

Plumbing contractor is responsible for repairing all areas damaged by plumbing work. All repairs must match existing surfaces as closely as possible.

3. Interior Carpentry: Install a pre-finished, hardwood handrail, secured to metal brackets, anchored to wall studding, at the basement and second floor stair locations. New handrails must be terminated with returns.

Re-secure the baluster/railing at the second floor landing.
