Dear Melissa

On February 26, 2003 @ 8:15 AM, I inspected the subject apartment for building code violations related to certain foul odors. The only obvious item found during this visit was a loose drain line in the pantry closet. This drain line is used for the water heater relief valve overflow. It appears to be somewhat disconnected at the point were it enters the wall. If the pipe is indeed broken and or disconnected in the wall as suspected, it would most certainly allow intrusion of sewer gases form the sanitary sewer system. These gases may be part or all of the noxious odors associated with the subject apartment.

I would strongly suggest requesting the landlord to repair the suspect sewer gas intrusion point. It is suggested that the repairs be inspected once completed.
