RECOMMENDATION

The Planning Commission recommends to the City Council that they approve the Preliminary Plat of Subdivision for land to be known as Lutheran Home Addition to the City of Napoleon with the following conditions:

- 1. That a stoned area be provided from the private drive around the condominiums to the property line of the Lutheran Home addition toward the 5th Street intersection. This stone must be wide enough and thick enough to support a fire truck in the spring when the ground is soft.
- 2. That sidewalks be placed at least on one side of the private street that are 4' wide and to City of Napoleon Standards.

BACKGROUND

An application by Richard A. Chase, Toledo, Ohio, on behalf of the Lutheran Development Corporation at Napoleon, Ohio, Inc. for Preliminary Plat of Subdivision approval for land inside the City of Napoleon Corporation Limit. application is in pursuant to Section 154.08 of the City of Napoleon, Ohio, Code of Ordinances. The property being subdivided is located East of (1036 S. Perry Street) the Lutheran Home. The six acre site is a parcel of land in the Northeast Quarter of Section 24, Town 5 North, Range 6 East, Napoleon Township, City of Napoleon, Henry County and is in a "B" and "C" Residential Zoning District.
