MILKSHAKE STAND -

- 1. The proposed building appears to be located on the water line easement. The line has been located for your review.
- 2. No plumbing isometrics submitted.

OTHER ISSUES -

- 1. There exists an unmetered service at the hog barn. The fair board received a letter from my office suggesting the elimination of this service or the installation a meter-to date nothing has been done.
- 2. We would like the fair board to address the current metering setup. One pit could be eliminated and we could set a new meter in the other, along with a shut off valve.



Subject: Henry County Fair Board Milkshake

Stand - Plan Review

Based upon my review of the preliminary plans submitted for the referenced project, I have developed the following comments:

- The site plan shows the milkshake stand relatively close to the existing twelve 1. (12) inch water main crossing the fairgrounds. It is my understanding that a twenty (20) foot easement is roughly centered on the water main. This permanent structure will need to be relocated off of that easement.
- A four (4) inch floor drain and a sink drain are noted as "Tie To Existing Site 2. Drain". Where does the existing drain outlet? It needs to be shown that it connects to a sanitary sewer.
- What water requirements, if any, will there be? Will there be a separate tap with 3. backflow prevention, or will this be fed from an existing service?
- Have the Electric Distribution and Operations Departments reviewed these 4. plans? I have yet to see any comments.
- 5. If not already paid, a \$25.00 plan review is required.
