BACKGROUND:

An application for public hearing has been filed by Noris Sanholtz, Ed Sanholtz and Brad VanDeBussche all of Napoleon. The applicants have filed a petition requesting a certain City street right of way and alley way be vacated. The subject right of way is know as the extension of Jefferson St. (an unimproved paper street) which runs between E. Riverview Ave. and E. Clinton St. Napoleon. The subject alley way is located between lots 110 & 111 of the Original Plat of Napoleon. The request is pursuant to Chapter 909 of City Code. The subject property is located in a "C-2" Community Commercial Zoning District.

RESEARCH AND FINDINGS:

- 1. Proper petition has been submitted along with the appropriate fees.
- City staff has reviewed the request and the following are our recommendations.
 - (a). That a 40 foot wide utility easement be retained in the center of the Jefferson St. right of way.
 - (b). That the owner of lot 111 grant a 15 foot wide utility easement for electrical distribution lines across said lot as dictated by the City Engineer.




