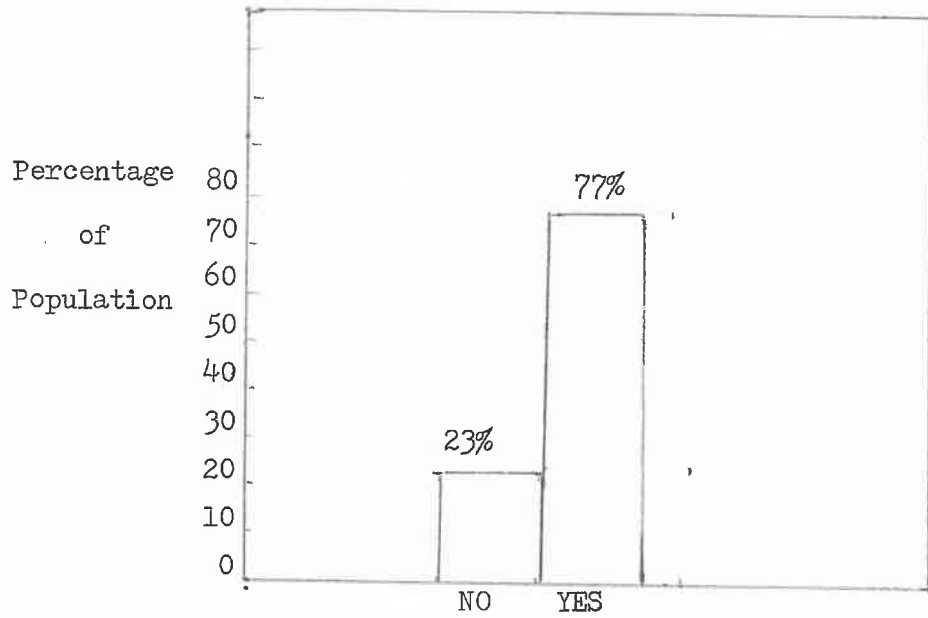
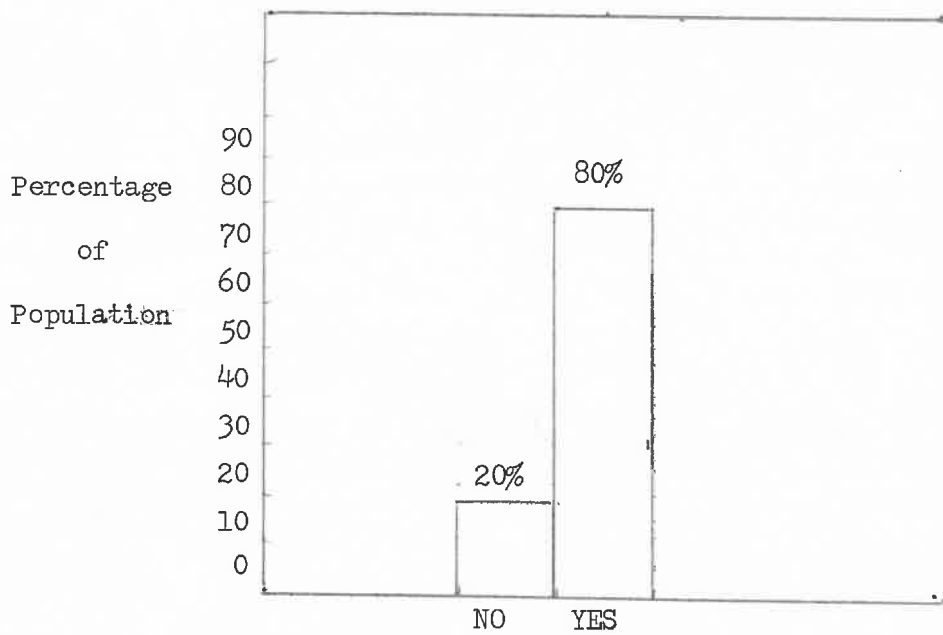

NUMBER OF TIMES PEOPLE PASS HOGREFE'S JUNKYARD

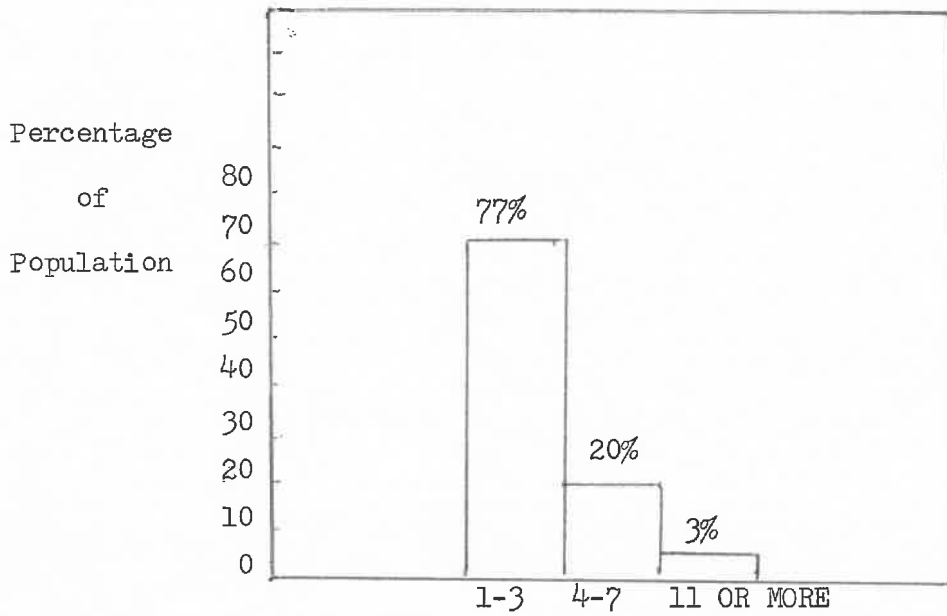

THE TYPE OF FENCE THAT IS PREFERRED

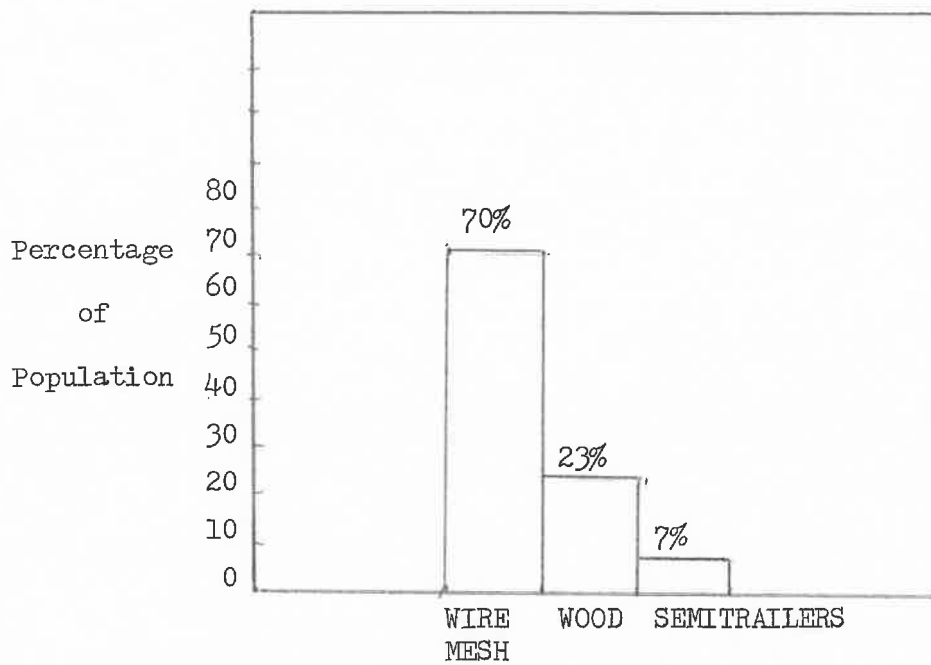

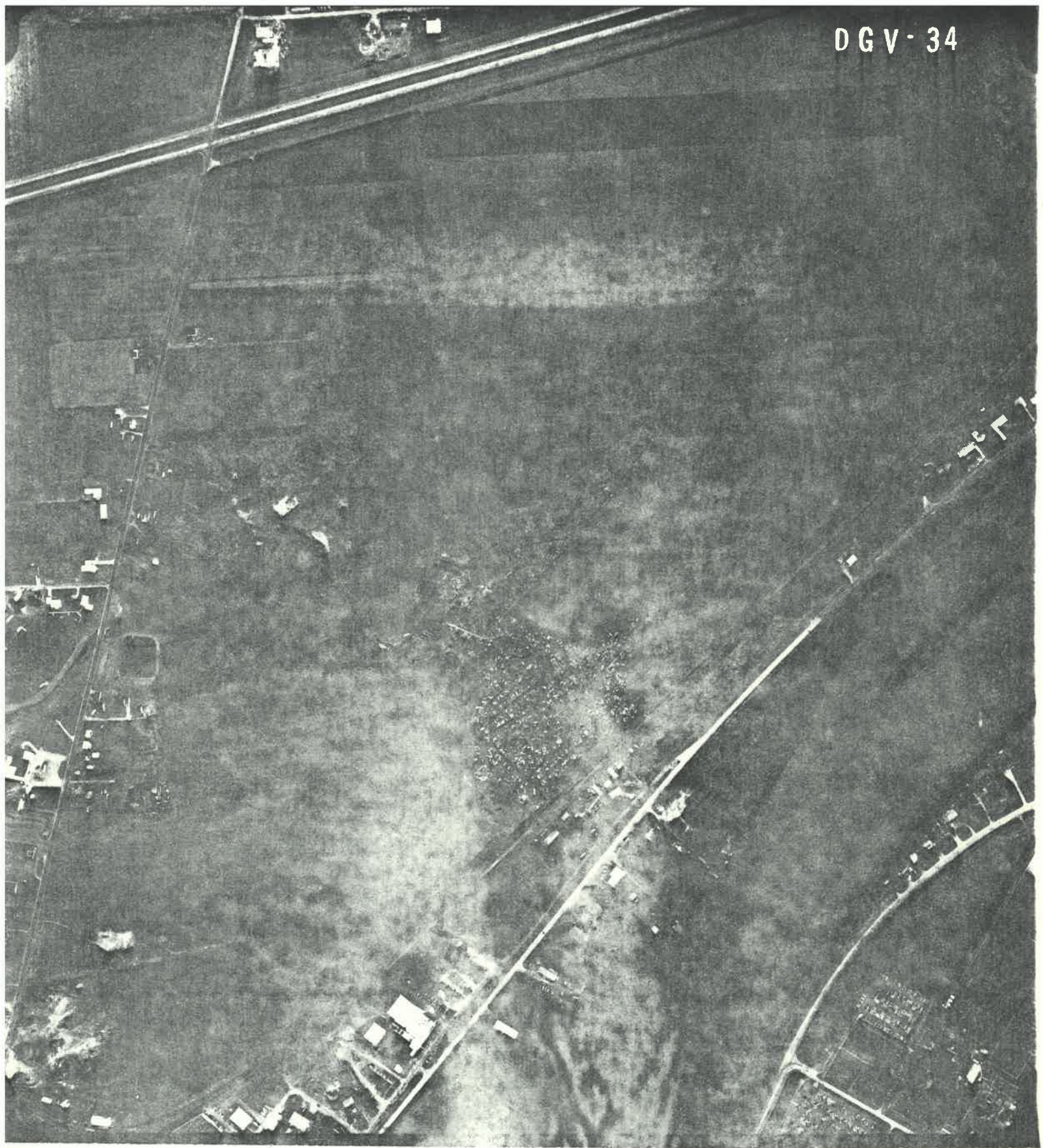
