Here are the specifications for repainting the Napoleon Municipal Building which you requested.

- I. Remove all rust, dirt, loose paint and chalk by Commercial sandblast.
- II. Apply 1 coat Metalatex Primer, B42 W100 or 2 coats Metalatex Semi Closs Enamel color of your choice.

OR.

- I. All existing chalk must be removed from building and roof by water blasting.
- II. Spot prime rusted surfaces with one coat Kromik Metal Primer, $\pm 41~\mathrm{Nl}_{\odot}$
- III. Apply I coat of Metalatex Semi Gloss Enamel color of your choice. Second coat should be applied for maximum protection.

Metalatex Semi Gloss Enamel should be applied at a spreading rate of 300 square feet per gallon. It can be applied by brush, roller or airless spray.
