Re: Concrete Walk Repairs, 1003 Scott Street

Dear Mr. Fruchey,

The City of Napoleon's Engineering Department has investigated a complaint regarding the concrete walk located at 1033 Scott Street. It was discovered that the existing concrete walk was never replaced after sewer work was completed.

Per the City of Napoleon Ordinances, the City Napoleon is required to use the BOCA National Property Maintenance Code 1996 for property maintenance requirements. After inspection of said property it was determined that the property is in violation of the following section of the above stated code:

PM 303.3 Sidewalks & Driveways: All sidewalks, walkways, stairs, driveways, parking spaces and similar areas shall be kept in a proper state of repair, and maintained free from hazardous conditions. Stairs shall comply with the requirements of Sections PM 304.10 and PM 702.9.

The above violations must be corrected by July 6, 2010. All proper permits must be obtained and all work inspected. A final inspection will be conducted in order for all violations to be considered corrected. Failure to comply by said date would be a misdemeanor of the third degree as stated in 1311.03 of the City of Napoleon Codified Ordinances.

Please contact the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department for copies of the specifications and to schedule the required inspections.

The BOCA National Property Maintenance Code adopted under this chapter is hereby amended as follows: PM 106.2 Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation, who shall violate any provision of this code, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree. Each day that violation continues after due notice has been served, in accordance with the terms and provisions hereof, shall be deemed a separate offense.
