City Engineer Adam C. Hoff, P.E. This letter is in response to our recent conversations regarding the water service at the proposed Quick Lube which is opening in Napoleon. The estimate for the water tap is \$3,100. Please see the enclosed attachment for the cost breakdown.

Your firm will be responsible to install the pipe from the point of the 4" tap valve to the building. The City will be allowing your firm to make a 1" tap for the domestic water service off the 4" line at or near the right-of-way. You will need to set a curb stop, box and rod assembly at the right-of-way for the domestic service. The curb stop assembly must meet the City of Napoleon specifications which are on file in the Engineering Department.

The City of Napoleon will be requiring backflow prevention at this site. You will need to place a dual detector check assembly on the fire line and a reduced pressure device on the domestic service.

The City will allow your firm to open cut Lagrange Street for the pipe placement. In doing this, you will be responsible to replace the street area back to its original condition. The pipe placement and restoration work must be scheduled with the Engineering Department for inspection. You will also be responsible for all signage, traffic control, road closings and contacting the local media of the time and date of the closing.

The following are changes and additions needed to the plans submitted on the above subject.

- 1. Dumpster screening required; show type and height proposed, also show thickness of concrete pad.
- 2. Change sanitary sewer size to 6", use ROMAC CB-6.66 UN tap saddle over cored hole in City main.
- 3. Show on site directional traffic signage.
- 4. Reduce height of Pennzoil post sign to eighteen (18) feet or less from finished grade to top of sign.
- 5. Place elevations on final plans as indicated on the enclosed drawing.
- 6. Show storm tap three (3) feet west of curb drain along Lagrange Street as shown on the enclosed drawings.
- 7. Show proposed drainage for the area around the post sign.
- 8. Show the City's ten (10) foot permanent utility easement along Lagrange street.
- 9. Move drive off City utility easement.
- 10. Show sidewalk cross section detail indicating proposed finished dirt grade and slopes. Sidewalks shall be placed one (1) foot north of south easement line as indicated on the enclosed drawing.

- 11. The City will provide a one (1) inch and a two (2) inch water tap to the location shown on the enclosed drawing. The cost of the one (1) inch tap to be \$650.00 and the cost of the two (2) inch tap to be \$1425.00.
- 12. The contractor is responsible for making the sanitary sewer tap as well as the storm sewer tap, the City inspection fee for these taps is \$100.00
- 13. The fire line and potable water risers shall be configured so that the backflow device is downstream from the City water meter as shown on the enclosed City installation spec.
