Dear Mr. Goodell:

Please be advised that the following trailers electrical entrances do not meet acceptable electrical standards and Codes, A-9 thru A-15, B-10 thru B-18, C-2 thru C-9, D-1 thru D-8, and need to be replaced as soon as possible.

The meter sockets in all locations and the main switch in most locations need to be replaced.

Pursuant to this end, the Board of Public Affairs have taken action. That action will not allow the connection of service to any location that makes any changes to a service point, (Iename change, disconnection for any reason) that does not meet acceptable standards and codes. The service will then remain off until such time that the service has been upgraded. We will be supplying you with the meter sockets as always.
