Dear Mr. Leupp:

Under the ordinances of the City of Napoleon, the parking, storing or placing of dilapidated, inoperable or unlicensed vehicles within a residential district is prohibited.

Two vehicles have been viewed in front of your garage for over the last few months. These vehicles shall be moved from the area within fifteen (15) days of this notice or the City shall take action to have the vehicles removed at the owner's expense.

Also, it has been viewed, the parking of a commercial vehicle on Kolbe St. over night and on weekends. Commercial vehicles are not to be stored or parked on residential property or streets, except to make deliveries.

This commercial vehicle will have to be kept elsewhere in a Commercial or Industrial area.
