Dear Sir:

A review of your drawings has been completed and the following questions were checked out.

- Sewer drains should go to some other outlet unless a new catch basin is constructed and existing pipe cleaned.
- Which footer detail will be used, Sheet 4 a or Sheet 1 of 2. Your draftsman informed me 4a sheet detail 8 X 8 columns would be used.
- The actual clearances of the canopy should be set. Your draftsman said approximately 14' 6" would be the clearance.
- 4. What material will be used for the canopy facia? Aluminum as per your draftsman.
- 5. OBBC 615.1.1.1 indicates canopies shall be located at least 10 ft. from any building on the same lot and face yards or streets not less than 40' on other sides.

Interpretation from BOCA on this section is that if the canopy is of fire resistant material it can extend over building and may set 10 ft. from streets or property lines.

I would like a letter confirming the answers by your draftsman.

Electrical review - general notes

- 2. All electrical facilities shall meet requirements of the National Electric Code 1981.
- 3. Single throw fusible main switches shall be required.
- 4. All electrical equipment shall have two paths to ground. One a driven rod and one to the service side of the water line.
- 5. All equipment shall be installed as per manufacturers instructions.
- 6. All electrical installations shall be installed under Class I Division 2 requirements of NEC 1981.

If there are any questions, please feel free to call. I have processed your permit applications. The permit fee is \$109.93.
