**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CERTAIN LICENSE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO AND JULIA ANN LUZNY
CONCERNING USE OF THE CITY'S BOULEVARD AT TWIN OAKS
SUBDIVISION FOR PLACEMENT OF A SIGN**

WHEREAS, Julia Ann Luzny has requested this City Council to allow her the use of the City right-a-way (boulevard) for placement of signs for Twin Oaks Subdivision;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Acting City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a license agreement, that is currently on file with the Finance Director, and is incorporated into this document by reference, between the City of Napoleon (hereinafter referred to as "the City") and Julia Ann Luzny to permit the placement of signs on city right-a-way in the boulevard area.

Section 2. That said agreement has been reviewed and approved by this Council, subject to any non-material change and deemed appropriate by the Acting City Manager and City Law Director. Further, after execution, the agreement shall be filed in the office of the City's Finance Director.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the City's Revised Code of General Ordinances.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 5. That this Resolution need only be referenced in the next revision of the City's Revised Code of General Ordinances.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN ANN LUZNY AND THE CITY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF STONE MAIL BOXES IN THE RIGHT OF WAY OF SEDWARD AVENUE AND NEWARD AVENUE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a license agreement with Ann Luzny in regard to the placement of Stone Mail Boxes in the right of way of Sedward Avenue and Neward Avenue, in the City of Napoleon, Ohio, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the license agreement that is currently on file in the office of the City Finance Director, said agreement is approved, subject to any non-material change deemed appropriate by the City Manager and approved by the City Law Director.



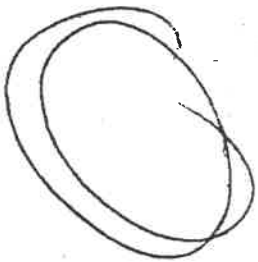


Seward

16 Mailboxes

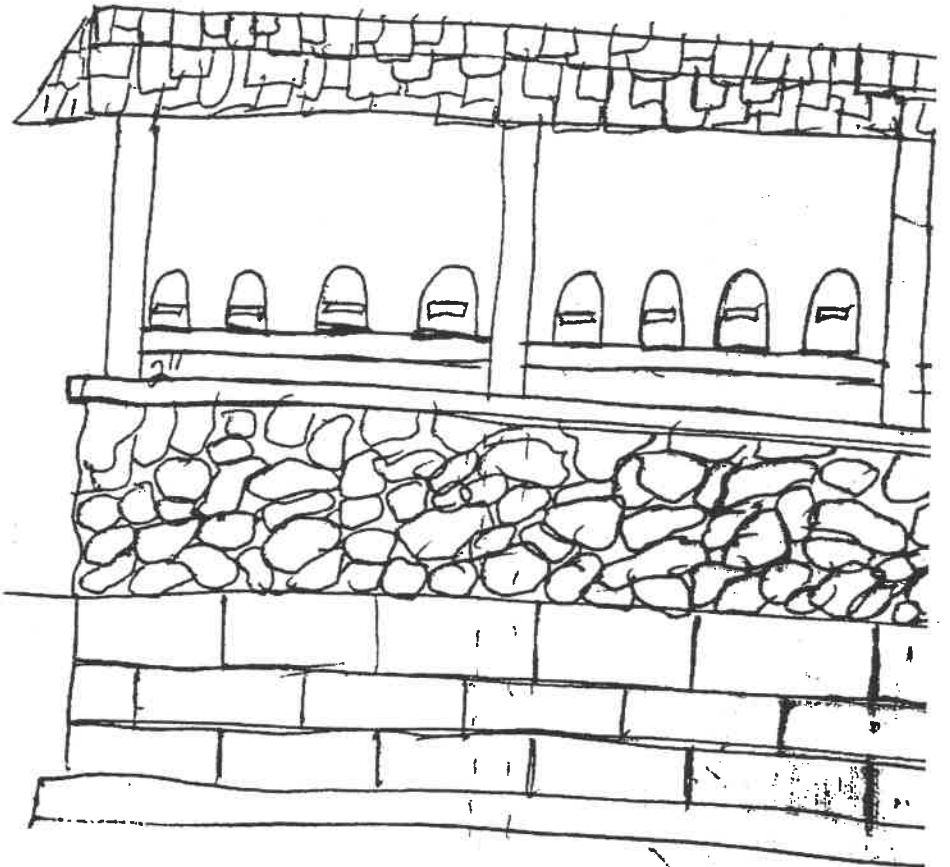
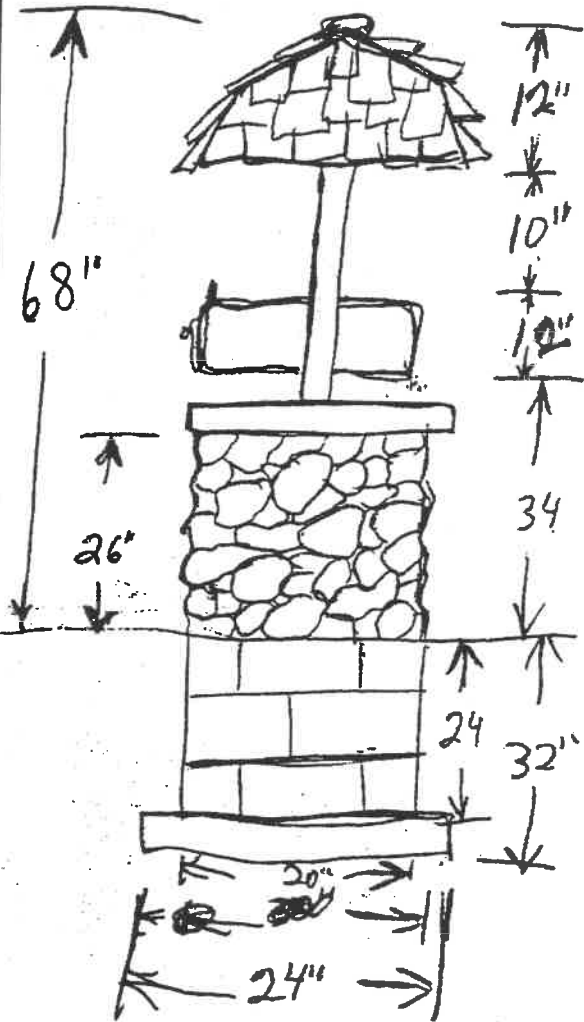
