1. Exterior doors: Replace each the front, south side, and garage entry doors with Stanley, Therma-Tru, or equal quality pre-hung insulated steel doors with light. Doors must be factory painted or contractor applied (TWO coats). Homeowner to select door style and color from contractor options (garage entry must be soil panel). Contractor must repair all damage incurred from door replacement.

Install Kwikset-Belaire Series or equal quality lockset with dead-bolt locks. Locks must be keyed alike.

2. Roofing: Remove all of the garage roof shingles, down to the sheathing. Affix 15# felt to roof decking and secure aluminum drip edge to roof perimeter edges. Install, per manufacturer's instruction, minimum 240# test weight/ Class A fire rated/ 30 year warranty/ fiberglass dimensional roof shingles. Homeowner to select shingle color.

3. Replacement windows: Wrap all of the exterior window and door trim with formed aluminum coil stock materials. Homeowner to select coil trim color. Install white vinyl replacement windows (Certaintec, Seaway, Great Lakes, or equal quality) to all of the windows throughout the structure.

NOTE- The interior and exterior perimeters must be properly caulked with window/door caulk.

4. Electrical:

Electrical Service - Install a 100 amp service entrance, complete with weather head, boot flash, mast, and meter. Locate at the south exterior wall of the home (outside the office/nursery).

Electrical Panel - Install a 100 amp/ twenty space electrical breaker panel and properly wire, bond, ground, and label. Locate panel in the office/nursery on the south wall.

Electrical wiring - Replace all ungrounded electrical wire throughout the entire structure with properly sized and grounded wire. Replace all devices (i.e switches/receptacles) with U.L approved devices.

Replace the air conditioner electrical feed with properly sized electrical wire, with ground.

Bathroom - GFCI protect the TWO(2) receptacles at the vanity area.

Utility - Place furnace wire in conduit.

Replace the furnace fuse (located at control switch) with 15 amp fuse.

Kitchen - Install a range hood vent, with light, directing exhaust to the homes exterior. Locate above the stove/oven.

GFCI protect all of the counter receptacles.

Install TWO (2) additional gfci protected receptacles. Locate at each the east wall (south of stove) and at the west end of bar/counter.

**Livingroom** - Install electrical wire feed and ONE (1) 8' length electric baseboard heater with individual thermostat control to heat the area.

Install ONE (1) additional wall receptacle. Locate at the west wall (south of stairs).

**Bedroom #1 (2<sup>nd</sup> floor/east)** - Install TWO (2) additional wall receptacles. Locate at each the east wall and south wall.

Install electrical wire feed and ONE (1) 8' length electric baseboard heater with individual thermostat control to heat the area.

**2<sup>nd</sup> floor landing** - Install TWO (2) additional wall receptacles. Locate at each the west wall and south wall.

**Smoke detectors** - Install FOUR (4) U.L approved, hardwired smoke detectors with battery back-up. Wire detectors in series. Locate at each of the following locations.. hallway (near kitchen), office/nursery, bedroom #2, and stair landing (top).

**CO detector** - Install ONE (1) U.L approved hardwired, with battery back-up CO detector. Locate in the hallway, outside the utility room.

**Exterior** - GFCI protect the garage wall receptacle on the south wall.

Install a wall switched light fixture in the garage attic, near the ladder access.

Install TWO (2) exterior gfci receptacles, complete with weather resistant cover. Locate ONE (1) at each the front and side entry.

**NOTE: All electrical work must conform to NEC and be performed by qualified technician(s).**

**5. Plumbing :**

**Bathroom** - Install gated shut-off valves to the vanity water supply lines.

**Utility** - Replace the clothes washer drain trap with ABS "p" trap.

Repair the cold water supply line and faucet at the sink, to allow water flow/operation.

**Exterior** - Install a frost-proof exterior sill cock with vacuum break. Install at existing spigot location.

**6. HVAC:** Perform a routine service (clean and tune) to the heating system. Service to include: oiling of the blower, replacement of defective belts, adjustment of belts, adjusting the blower, adjustment of pilot, replacing defective thermocouple, cleaning of pilot/heat exchanger/burner compartment, filter replacement, adjusting of the main burners for efficiency.

**NOTE: Furnace work must be performed by a qualified furnace technician.**

**Garage** - Install, per manufacturers instruction, wooden pull down attic access ladder. Locate at existing access opening in the garage.
