Mr. Tandy:

There is something that I would like to call to your attention.

Four seasons of the year—during or following rain, snow, mist, or any kind of precipitation at all—pedestrians are showered from above when they walk along the Murphy Store from the Washington Street Corner—North on Perry. This is a hazzard and I am wondering if the overhang on the roof might be deteriorating to such an extent that sometime a piece might fall down on someone. Even if the overhang is sound—it evidently needs some kind of repair as you can be showered long after precipitation.

Landowners are expected to keep sidewalks in good repair—but to me, a roof that is old and deteriorating, is even more of a hazzard for anyone passing below.

Could this be called to the attention of the owner of the building, or possibly checked out by the building inspector—or whoever should check it out?
