SUBJECT: Violation of Ordinance No. 404

Building Code

Dear Mr. Germann:

On August 9, 1960 I made an inspection of the building at 117 W. Washington Street which is being remodeled by your company. In talking with your electrician on the job, he stated that some of the existing asbestos insulated conductors were to be used in the basement. The use of this type of conductor is prohibited in a business location by the National Electrical Code which is a part of Ordinance No. 404. The recommended method is to use a rigid metal conduit as a carrier for all conductors.

If there are any questions you or the owner of the building may have concerning our new building code we would be happy to answer them.
