matter.

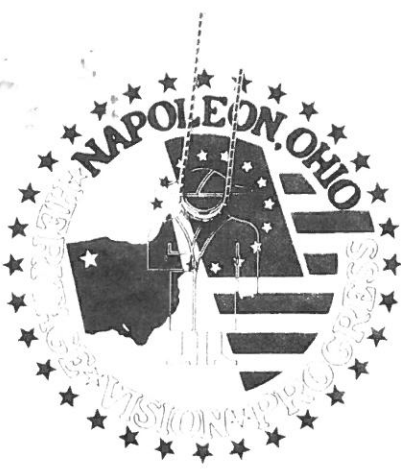

Dear Mrs. Thiel:

The City of Napoleon has again, for the second year, received complaints concerning the bags of leaves placed around your home at 611 W. Washington.

I talked to Mr. Wilson about the leaves last year and he moved them to his property on Sycamore Drive. The leaves constitute a nuisance under the City of Napoleon Codes 92.01 Section (D).

I have talked to the City Manager and he said that if they were placed along the tree lawn next to the curb, the City would remove them for a charge of \$5.

If the leaves are placed on Mr. Wilson's property on Sycamore, we will have to site him for removal.

The leaves shall be either set on the tree lawn or removed from the lot within 15 days of date of this notice.
