PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. PC-03-05

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPLAT OF THE EAST HALF OF LOT 62 AND LOT 63 OF WILLIAM SHEFILED'S ADDITION TO NAPOLEON LOCATED AT 703 W. WASHINGTON STREET AND 619 NORTON AVENUE IN THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO.
