n to the sheeting, and dispose of off-site. Secure 15# roof felt to the entire roof area and affix aluminum drip edge to the roof perimeter. Install, per manufacturer's instruction, new, minimum 240#, Class A fire rated, fiberglass dimensional roof shingles. Install a minimum of SEVEN (7) square metal roof vents, spaced equally along the roofs. Approximately TWENTY-SIX (26) squares roofing material required. Homeowner to select shingle color. Contractor is responsible for own measurements in computing bid.

At the front entry porch roof, cut back the edges of the sheeting, mechanically fasten 1/2" blac insulation board, and install, per manufacturer's instruction, Design A, fully adhered, glued down, rubber roof membrane. Install perimeters, using proper rubber edging compound. Approximately ONE (1) square roofing material required. Contractor is responsible for own measurements in computing bid.

2. Exterior Carpentry: Trench along the exterior foundation perimeter, approximately SIX in.(6"). Re-tuck all missing and/or deteriorated mortar joints. Clean off all loose dirt and debris from the foundation block. Apply, per manufacturer's instruction, TWO (2) coats of "Thoroseal" or equal product. Return soil to original elevation.

To the ceiling of the front entry porch roof, secure new 1/2" T-111 material. After completion of installation, apply ONE (1) coat of exterior latex exterior primer and TWO (2) coats of exterior latex paint to the exposed band board and T-111 material.

3. Insulation: To the entire interior crawlspace foundation perimeter walls, excavate soil around the base and secure 4' X 8' - 2" styrofoam insulation board. Insulation board must be secured, using construction adhesive. Return soil to the base of the walls. Contractor is responsible for own measurements in computing bid.

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To the heat supply ducts, install insulation blanket or insulation wrap to the ducts. Install eave baffles to prevent insulation from blocking eave ventilation. Install blocking around all heat producing devices, vent fans, non IC rated recessed light fixtures, and active chimneys and flues. Install blown-in cellulose insulation, approximately SIX in. (6") in depth and uniformly spread. Install studding and 2" insulation board to separate the house attic from the garage attic area.



4. Window Replacement: Replace the existing windows with white vinyl, double glazed replacement windows with half screen and locks. Install new trim material where needed. Replace all damaged trim material. New trim must match existing materials as closely as possible. The approximate sizes and locations of the windows are.....

INTERIOR

1. Electrical: Replace the existing electrical service entrance with a 100 amp service entrance. Replace the existing fuse panel with a U.L. approved, 100 amp, TWENTY (20) space breaker panel. New panel is to be relocated to the East wall of the Utility room. New panel must be properly wired, grounded, bonded, and labeled.

Replace all of the existing wiring to all of the receptacles, switches, and light fixtures, using #12 AWG "Romex". Replace all appliance wire with properly sized, grounded wire.

Replace all of the receptacles and switches throughout the house and garage.

Place all junction boxes in the attic area on rigid extensions, approximately 8" above the tops of the ceiling joists.

Utility: Replace the duplex receptacle at the clothes washer with a single receptacle.

Wire the existing ceiling light fixture to a wall switch and remove the pull chain. Den: Replace the existing closet light with a wall switched, flourescent light fixture.

Bedroom #2: Install ONE (1) additional receptacle at the East wall location.

Replace the existing closet light fixture with a wall switched, flourescent light fixture. Bedroom #1: Replace the existing closet light fixture with a wall switched, flourescent light Bathroom: Replace the existing lighted mirror with a wall switched, 24" X 36", lighted cosmetic/medicine box, cost not to exceed \$ 140.00, less installation. Homeowner to select style.

Install a GFCI protected receptacle at the sink/vanity area.

Livingroom: Replace the existing closet light with a wall switched, flourescent light fixture. Smoke Detectors: Install ONE (1) U.L. approved, hardwired smoke detector with battery back-up. Locate outside the bedrooms, in the hall area.

Kitchen: Install a minimum of TWO (2) separate appliance circuits.

Replace the TWO (2) existing receptacles at the counter area with GFCI protected receptacles and install TWO (2) additional GFCI protected receptacles. TOTAL of FOUR (4).

Garage: All wall receptacles must be GFCI protected.

Exterior GFCI's: Install TWO (2) GFCI receptacles in weather proof boxes with covers. Locate ONE (1) at the front entry and ONE (1) outside the garage exterior wall.

Note Remove the existing wire and receptacle to the shed.

Lawn light fixture: Replace the existing wire feed to the lawn light fixture with #12 AWG UF wire. Install exposed wire in conduit.

NOTE: All electrical work must conform to NEC and local regulations and be performed by qualified electrical technician.

Electrical contractor is responsible for repairing all areas damaged by electrical work (contractor is not responsible for any damage to existing wall paper). All repairs must match existing surfaces as closely as possible.

2. Interior Carpentry: crawlspace; Install proper support strapping to the existing waste drains, at FOUR ft. (4') intervals.

Install 1/2" drywall to the South wall of the Utility room, where electrical fuse panel has been removed. Tape all joints and apply, per manufacturer's instruction, drywall joint compound. Sand joints to a smooth, uniform surface and apply ONE (1) coat of interior latex primer.

3. Plumbing: Replace the gas supply line to the water heater with black iron, complete with drip leg and shut off valve.

Replace the pressure/temperature relief line with 3/4" copper, extending to within 3" of floor. Plug the hole remaining in the floor, resulting from pipe removal. Place the tank on a drip pan.
