Sometime during the past weekend, the barrels and caution tape that were barricading your drive were removed. There is evidence that the concrete approach was driven on. This letter shall serve as notice that if the concrete approach cracks or breaks, the replacement of this concrete will be your responsibility.

Concrete is required to cure for seven (7) days prior to any vehicles traveling over it. Because you chose to remove the barricade that was erected by the Contractor and the City, all maintenance responsibilities shall revert back to you.
