If this is the case, then she is responsible for the abatement of insects at her own home. If she cannot afford to do this or refuses to, isn't there some type of assistance she can get from your office? If you currently provide services to her, why couldn't you deny service until such time the roaches are abated. It would make sense that this is a health hazard to you and your associates.

If this matter were abated by the City (through the Property Maintenance Code), Mrs. Rodriquez would face fines of up to \$100.00 per day and possible jail time. I do not believe it is in the best interest of your client as this would cause further hardship to her. In my opinion this matter is best handled by your office with assistance from the Health Department.
