Re: Sewer Relocation Notice

Dear Mr. Gustwiller,

This letter is to notify you that, according to our records, the sanitary sewer tap for your property has yet to be relocated from the storm sewer to the sanitary sewer. This work will need to be completed within ninety (90) days from the date of this letter.

Because this situation poses a health risk to the residents in the area of this improper connection, action must be taken to correct this matter. The "City of Napoleon Rules for Water and Sewer Service" outline the actions that the City may take for improperly connected sanitary sewer taps:

Rule 15 – Discontinuation of Service:


Rule 15.1 Right to Disconnect

- (A) The City has the right to discontinue the supply of water and/or sewer service or refuse to furnish the same for any of the following reasons:
 - (6) For improper installation of a nature that would jeopardize, contaminate or otherwise effect the service to customers;
 - (7) For installing any water or sewer line or apparatus in a manner that is contrary to these Rules or City specifications;

Please note that if the corrective work is not completed within the allowable time period, your water service may be terminated. Please forward to the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department your proposed schedule for completion of the work. Also, all permitting and inspections that are required for this work shall be coordinated through the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department.

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

Re: Sewer Relocation Notice

Dear Mr. Gustwiller,

It has come to the City of Napoleon's attention that the sewage from your residence is connected to the City of Napoleon's storm sewer. Per Ohio E.P.A. orders and the City of Napoleon's Water & Sewer Rules, this is prohibited. All sanitary sewer services must be connected to sanitary sewer mains.

This letter is to alert you of the situation and to serve notice that this issue must be corrected immediately. You are hereby directed to remove your sanitary sewer service from the existing storm sewer and reroute it to the existing sanitary sewer. You have until April 30, 2009 (six (6) months) to address this issue or legal action may be taken.

Please note that there are programs available to POSSIBLY assist you with the cost of this relocation. This information is available through the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department. Also, all required permits and inspections can be arranged by contacting the City of Napoleon's Engineering Department.
