RESEARCH AND FINDING





A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF A PLAT– KNOWN AS CLAIRMONT AVE. RIGHT-OF-WAY BEING PART OF THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 14T5N, R6E, LYNWOOD ADDITION DEDICATION PLAT" IN THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO

Whereas, this Owner, Napoleon City School, has legal ownership of certain real property being Clairmont Ave. being part of the Southwest ¼ of Section 14T5N, R6E, Lynwood addition, in the City of Napoleon, Henry County, Ohio; and,

Whereas, a certain street exists known as Clairmont Ave., between the streets of Briarheath Ave. and Westmorland Ave. that has been used and maintained By the owner, Napoleon City Schools, and has requested this section to be dedicated and accepted as a public street; and,

Whereas, the City's Engineering department is unable to locate a record evidencing the dedication and acceptance of the said street, at least in the entirety as now used as a public street; Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

Section 1. That, it is the recommendation of this Planning Commission that the Plat known as the Clairmont Ave. Right of Way Dedication Plat" situated in the City of Napoleon, County of Henry, State of Ohio, be approved, and the Right of Way (Street) be hereby accepted by the City as a public street.

Section 2. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Commission concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this Commission, and that all deliberations of this Commission and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Codified Ordinances of Napoleon Ohio.
