A RESOLUTION STRONGLY OPPOSING THE PASSAGE OF HB 5 BY THE OHIO GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHICH PROPOSES UNIFORMITY MEASURES FOR MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX IN THE FORM OF UNFUNDED MANDATES AND A SUBSTANTIAL LOSS OF REVENUE

The City of Napoleon, after suffering the loss of the revenue from the Local Government Fund, Estate Tax, and Tangible Personal Property Tax, now strongly opposes HB 5 which will result in an additional estimated loss of \$260,000.00 of revenue. Additionally, HB 5 drastically weakens local government control and oversight for municipal income tax administration and the policies and procedures for municipal income tax collection. Finally, the long term purpose of HB 5 is State oversight of municipal income tax operations. All of which the City of Napoleon strongly opposes.
